2. Who are the spiritually lost people that you have regular contact with? How could you care more deeply about their salvation?
3. What has God forgiven *you* of that would cause you to be more gracious toward fellow sinners?
4. The hardest part of having a faith-conversation with someone is getting it started. What are some opening lines or approaches you could use to open up a conversation about Jesus with others? If people need to hear the *bad* news before they can understand the *good* news, how can you present the *bad* news (i.e., sin) in a way that doesn't shut down the conversation?
5. What role does God play in your spiritual conversations with lost friends?
6. What gets you more worked up (negatively or positively) than others' lostness? How could you keep these things from eclipsing Jesus in your life and conversations?
7. Have you ever been on a *GO Team trip*? If so, what was the highlight of it for you? If not, what keeps you from going in 2019?
