DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY, FRIENDS & GROUPS

This week's sermon taught the COMMA Bible study method using John 1:1-12 as its text. Now choose a different passage from this week's Bible Savvy Reading Schedule (available on the CCCLife mobile app or at cclife.org/biblesavvy) and walk through the COMMA steps.

Begin by reading your passage out loud.

Context. Review what you've learned about John's Gospel from the Bible Project video (YouTube) and/or the NIV Study Bible introduction to John.

Observations/T-R-T-S (treats). What is the theme (T) of your passage? What are the repeating words or ideas (R) you see--and what is the significance of each? What are some truths about God (Father, Son or Spirit) that can be found in this passage? Did something striking (S) jump out at you? Explain.

Message. Take one of your observations and note the timeless truth or principle that it seems to teach. (If you're doing this in a CG, have each person note their own.)

Meditation. What's the point of this step? How do you do it?

Application. It's time to get very practical. How might you specifically apply the message (which you took away from this passage) to your own life today?

Prayer Prompt: Using the passage of scripture from today's discussion, read the passage out loud. See what stands out to you as you imagine yourself in the passage. Use your 5 senses to really engage with the story. Take a few minutes to pray or journal about what you observe.
