## **EXPLORE– Leap Frog**

*During Explore, your kids engage in fun, creative activities designed to pique their curiosity about the day's portion of The Big God Story.*

### **Supplies:**

- Bin filled with rice/pasta/sand etc.
- Small toy frogs/bugs
- Playdough (optional)

Hide the frogs and bugs in the bin of rice or pasta. If you rather, you can hide them in playdough instead. Invite your children to look for things hidden inside the bin or playdough. As they find the frogs and bugs have them tell you what they are finding. Ask: **Why do you think we are finding lots of frogs and bugs in the bin? What do you think that frogs and bugs have to do with today's Big God Story?**

## **WATCH THE KIDSWORLD ONLINE VIDEO**

Read the story of The Ten Plagues from an appropriate children's Bible, or show your child where it can be found in your Bible, so they can see the Bible is interesting and true!

## **RESPOND**

*During respond time, kids reflect on what the Holy Spirit is teaching them and respond through creative activities and games.*

Today in The Big God Story we heard how God used Moses to convince Pharaoh to let the Israelites leave Egypt.

- How did Moses listen to God?
- Why do you think Pharaoh had such a hard time listening to what God wanted?
- Does God hear you when you talk to him?
- Is there ever a time when God doesn't hear you?

## **CREATE: Caring Page**

*Create is more than just a time to make a craft. It's a hands-on opportunity for children to give artistic expression to what God is doing within them. What is created can then become a physical reminder of time spent responding to God.*

### **Supplies:**

- Chenille wires
- Pony Beads

Today we are going to make Moses' staff. Show your children how to fold over the end of the Chenille wire and then put the beads onto the wire. Have them use any color/pattern they wish. When they have their wire full of beads, show them how to fold over the opposite end so the beads will not come off. Then show them how to bend the wire so that it forms a staff.

What did a staff have to do with The Big God Story today? Do you remember where we saw it? How did God listen to the Israelites? Today in our story we learned that God heard the prayers of His people, the Israelites, who were slaves in Egypt. God allowed ten bad things to happen to the Egyptians before Pharaoh let them go. God listened to His people the Israelites, and He listens to us too!
